Caregivers Support Group meets each month on the **second Tuesday at 1:00 pm** in the church library. Join other Caregivers to gain information, share ideas, problem solve, and support each other. Facilitated by Brandi Schneider, LMSW.

Our support group for Widow(er)s meets at the church library at **Noon** on the **first and third Wednesdays** of each month. If you grieve, you don't have to grieve alone. This is such a loving, encouraging, and supportive group of people. You will feel welcome and cared for. There are occasional luncheon outings, particularly on the 5th Wednesdays of months.

A support group for people with Parkinson's and their Caregivers meets the **first Wednesday** of each month in the church library at **10 am**. This is open to anyone in the community.

We are exploring the New Testament thru a series of lectures from the Great Courses called, "Understanding the New Testament" by Dr David Brakke. This will take up about thirty minutes, and then we'll spend 30 minutes discussing the topics he raises. We meet **Wednesdays in the church library at 6 PM.** All are welcome to attend.

Our church showers are open to men and women so they can freshen up, do a load of laundry, and be ready for a job interview, medical appointment, or just a chance to be clean. Showers are available Monday and Wednesdays, 9 AM till 1:00 PM. Volunteers are needed, flexible scheduling.

Thank you to all the individuals who have stepped up in a big way to keep our church, narthex, bathrooms, and church offices and meeting areas spic & span! You really make a huge difference!

**Emergency Food Relief.** We are asking that the next couple of Sundays you clean out your pantries and bring canned food to the church to be given to people in need. We are partnering with Scouts Troop 67, so if you haven't received your collection bag from them just bring your food here. Government benefits have ended and this will effect many in our community.

**Mobile Food Pantry** church parking lot the **2nd and 4th Wednesdays of each month**. Cars start lining up at 8:30 AM and we distribute until the food runs out, typically within an hour. If you are homebound and do not have a friend or neighbor who can pick up for you, contact Bill Featherstone (479.981.1991) by Noon on Mondays to be added to our very limited delivery schedule.

**United Women, of Faith** will be volunteering at the CS Bank Parking Lot downtown ES on **Saturday November 15** from 8-4 PM. On **Sunday, November 16**, UWF will gather after Sunday Service and share fellowship and a baked potato bar-YUM!
